
Getting to Belfast:

Getting to Riddell Hall from Queen's:


Riddell Hall is located to the south of the main Queen's campus, approximately a 15 minute walk away. Bus route 8A runs a regular service from the city centre to Riddell Hall, via the main Queen's campus:

Getting to Riddel Hall from Central Station:

It is a 40 minute walk from Central Station to Riddel Hall along the embankment. Alternatively taxi services are available, or take bus 8A from the city centre.



Getting to Riddel Hall from Europa bus station:


It is a 30 minute walk from the Europa bus station to Riddel Hall. Alternatively, take bus 8A from outside the station. Taxi services are also available.

Getting to the conference room:

The meeting will take place in the Weston Lecture Theatre in the teaching block at Riddel Hall. This is shown on the map below.

As you come up the driveway to Riddel Hall, you will see the main building in front of you. The smaller modern building on the left as you face the main building is the teaching block, where the conference will be held.

Wi- Fi:

Wi-Fi is free in the Conference Facility. If you wish to use the facility please choose the network 'The Cloud'. You will need to open your web browser and refresh to see The Cloud homepage (<http://www.thecloud.net/>). An account using your email address must be created the first time you login. From then on 'The Cloud' will automatically recognise your device in any Queens' hotspot. EDUROAM is also available, although you may need to register with your home institution in advance.

Parking:

There is a car park at Riddel Hall, however we cannot guarantee that spaces will be available on the day. Please email the organiser if you would like to request a spot. There may also be on street parking available outside Riddel Hall.
