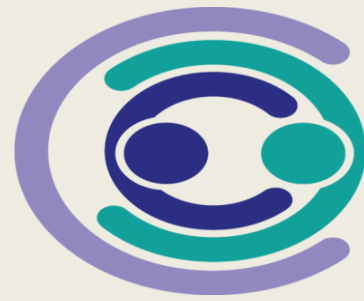

# The Evaluation

- 25 outpatient clinics
- Demonstration in waiting area
- Bookmark and pen
- Online evaluation
- Follow up Interviews

# Results



- 461 visits in 2 months
- 55 cancer caregivers completed online survey
